Kerisiano Ti'a Savea, age 69, of Halawa, passed away on May 15, 2015 at Tripler Army Medical Center. He was born on May 2, 1948 in Pagopago, American Samoa. He attended and graduated from Radford High School. Soon after graduating from High School, he joined the U. S. Marine Corps. He then retired from the USMC, after serving three tours of duty in Vietnam. Following his retirement from the USMC, he worked as a Bus Driver for "The Bus", followed by employment with the Pearl Harbor Public Works Center as a Mechanic. Known as "Chris" he was an avid Fisherman and considered the Ocean his first home.
